Meeting called to order at 7:00pm by Lynette Robinson, Chairperson.

Welcome to New Members Kellie Milne and Trey Bodnick. The new members gave a brief background on themselves and their interest in working on the Commission. The other members then gave a brief review of their respective time on the Commission: Ms. Robinson, 34 years. Mr. Bishop 16 years. Mr. Dailey 4 years.

The Directors Report, prepared by Mark Marino, was provided to all and reviewed.

Old Business: The By-Laws are being reviewed by the commission members to ensure they accurately reflect the current state of the Commission and the prospective future as well. At the next Commission meeting, suggestions regarding appropriate amendments will be discussed and agreed upon and then sent onto the Wilton Town Board, subject to their approval.

New Business: An open discussion ensued regarding looking to other properties the Town owns that have the potential to be used to meet the recreational needs of the Town residents. Article II of the By-Laws state this as one of the primary functions of this Commission. The Commission members will seek to first obtain a better understanding of what land is potentially available for recreational needs. Once determined, the commission shall proceed with a close examination of those properties and consideration of what specific uses they may be suited for, subject to review by the Town Board.

The Commission now has 6 members and one more is needed to fulfill Article III of the By-Laws stating that there will be 7 voting members. Commission members were asked to try and identify a prospective new member.

Next meeting will be September 12th.
