You are Invited to join the Historic Preservation Board as we present the 2022 Historic Preservation Award to Michael Blaauboer, owner of the Brill Mansion located at 683 Route 9, Wilton.

The Brill House, also known as the Pepper Turkey Farm House, was built in approximately 1850. At the time it was built it was one of the most stately homes around. The property served the community of Wilton in several capacities over the years but in recent years fell into neglect. Michael stepped forward and saved this treasured landmark; in the process he has turned the home into what some call “The Jewel of Wilton”.

The Wilton Heritage Society will co-host the event with the Town of Wilton Historic Preservation Committee. The event will take place at The Brill Mansion, 683 Route 9, at 6PM on Wednesday May 18th. Michael has graciously offered tours of the house to anyone interested that evening.

This is a wonderful opportunity to see the transformation of this treasure up close, from the rooftop belvedere to the barns and outbuildings.
